

Heimo - A Story

I got together for an interview with the customer relationship manager Eetu Kamppuri from the young company Heimo Films. Eetu has graduated from Pro Academy and started a company with the inspiration he got from there.

Me: Start by telling a bit about you and your company. What's your role in Heimo Films?

Ecetu: We all work in all roles flexibly in our firm. But my main role is being the customer relationship manager (CRM). I take care of the already existing customer relations and handle a lot of the sales. I also take part in making productions.

Me: What sparked your interest in entrepreneuship?

Ecetu: My dad has always been an entrepreneur and in that sense it did spark my interest. I also see my self as a more of a doer personality, so I wanted something practical I could to concretely. I wasn't a fan of sitting in a class and studying.

We read a lot of books and the theories are taken into practice this way.

Me: How long has the business been running?

Eetu: We've officially been in business for 8 months now. We came up with the Heimo Films brand around a year ago through our work in Pro Academy.

Me: How has having been in Pro Academy reflected to Heimo?

Eetu: When I went to Pro Academy, I didn't really know what I wanted from it or what I could get from it. But the biggest thing has definitely been emphasizing it to honest and direct teamwork, the power of dialogue and operating openly.

Me: How did it all come to be?

Eetu: First we started shooting videos for fun with our friend's camera. Then it really took off and started to get demand. We began building our knowledge by just shooting more and more and during the last spring semester, we agreed collectively to continue this after our studies.

Me: How many employees does Heimo have?

Eetu: We are five in total and have two trainees. We have all graduated from Pro Academy's Entrepreneurship and team leadership degree.

Me: What are your company's values?

Eetu: A really major thing for us is that the customer feels happy and comfortable while working with us from the very beginning. I don't wanna say 'from beginning 'til the end' because we want to develop longlasting relationships and network with all kinds of people.

Our logo has a bonfire on it and the word Heimo. Heimo refers to doing things together and working as one. The bonfire symbolizes growth. We partner with growing companies who also have that mentality. And we want to grow the scene even bigger and do it collectively. We don't do things seriously, we do them properly. We don't want to ease on quality but want to assure that the customer is always content. We want to stand out and stay really direct about our ideas and thoughts within our company, internally and externally.

Me: What was your experience like in Pro?

Eetu: It always felt safe to speak out about anything. One thing I also learned is that you can always learn different skills but what really matters in teamwork is, what kind of traits do you utilize in it and how you make the diverse team benefit from everyone's unique differences.

Me: What advice would you give for those new students who are considering applying for Pro Academy?

Eetu: I think if you're considering the Academy as an option, the biggest thing would be to just go for it. Don't let your doubts hold you back. And don't keep yourself from applying if it's only because you don't quite know what your thing is yet. Don't be afraid of the amount of responsibility, when you really love what you do, it will keep you going and you'll do it gladly.

Me: And how about those who are hoping to start their own business someday but aren't sure whether or not it's for them?

Eetu: My friend who gratuated from Pro Academy once told me that first you go into it losing yourself until you find yourself. You don't have to already know what you want or what's for you before you go into it. It'll come to you along the way.

Me: Why would someone choose Pro Academy?

Eetu: Pro Academy has amazing opportunities to gain connections and people in your life who will know how to help you even after your journey there. It's super good for your business life in the future. I definitely want to encourage you to network and connect.

After Pro Academy I really feel like I've found myself. Before I never got a hold of my true self. I was just used to the picture that societal norms have painted for young men.

Me: Would you say you found the right industry for you?

Letu: 4,5 years ago when I got into Pro, I had no idea whatsoever, that I would be starting a B2B video production company. But when you really find the right people around you and find something interesting in it and are excited and open to learn, just wing it. Take the chance. You'll never know what tomorrow brings. Don't think too much in the future and hold back because of needing to stay true to your original plan.

I won't ignore the possibility of getting into something else in the future. But right now this feels like the right path and I'm here for it. **Me:** What does the future look like for Heimo?

Eetu: In the future, we see each other building this company big time. We want to see each other leading and managing our own business and choose a production manager better than us and recrute our own staff. So that we can cater to any need. We are eager to get global at some point as well.

Student overalls are something you will get extremely familiar with. You'll get introduced to them soon enough. Overalls are an essential in universities and universities of applied scienses especially in Finland. They are something you will wear with pride. (This can of course be debatable in the morning after the student party night when you find yourself wearing the same overalls in class, but don't worry, you won't be alone though). Your overalls bind you to TAMK, they will tell you and your mates from your school and other schools what you study, what study year you are in and what's your degree. It also shows, how many achievements, also known as patches, you have managed to sew on these overalls. It will become your masterpiece and full of memories when you graduate.

You will be given different patches for different achievements and different events. You have already been handed a few from our events. You can also collect them by going into events as well as being active and earning them. There are also groups in Facebook and our beloved Solu desk where they sell them. Show off your sewing (or glueing) skills and customize the garment to represent you!

How to wear the overalls?

So first, put them on like you'd be wearing pants. Then close a few buttons/the zipper and grab the sleeves. Tie a not with them as shown in the first photo from the front.

If the pant leg is too long, you can either: roll it; tighten it with an elastic band; sew it or cut it if you will. Whatever feels the most comfortable for you and/or visually pleasing. If it feels too loose on you, put a belt around it.


